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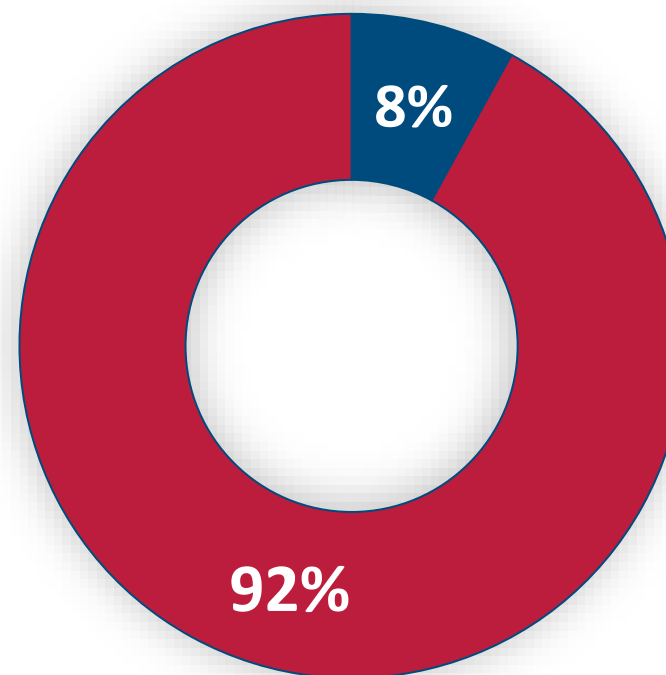

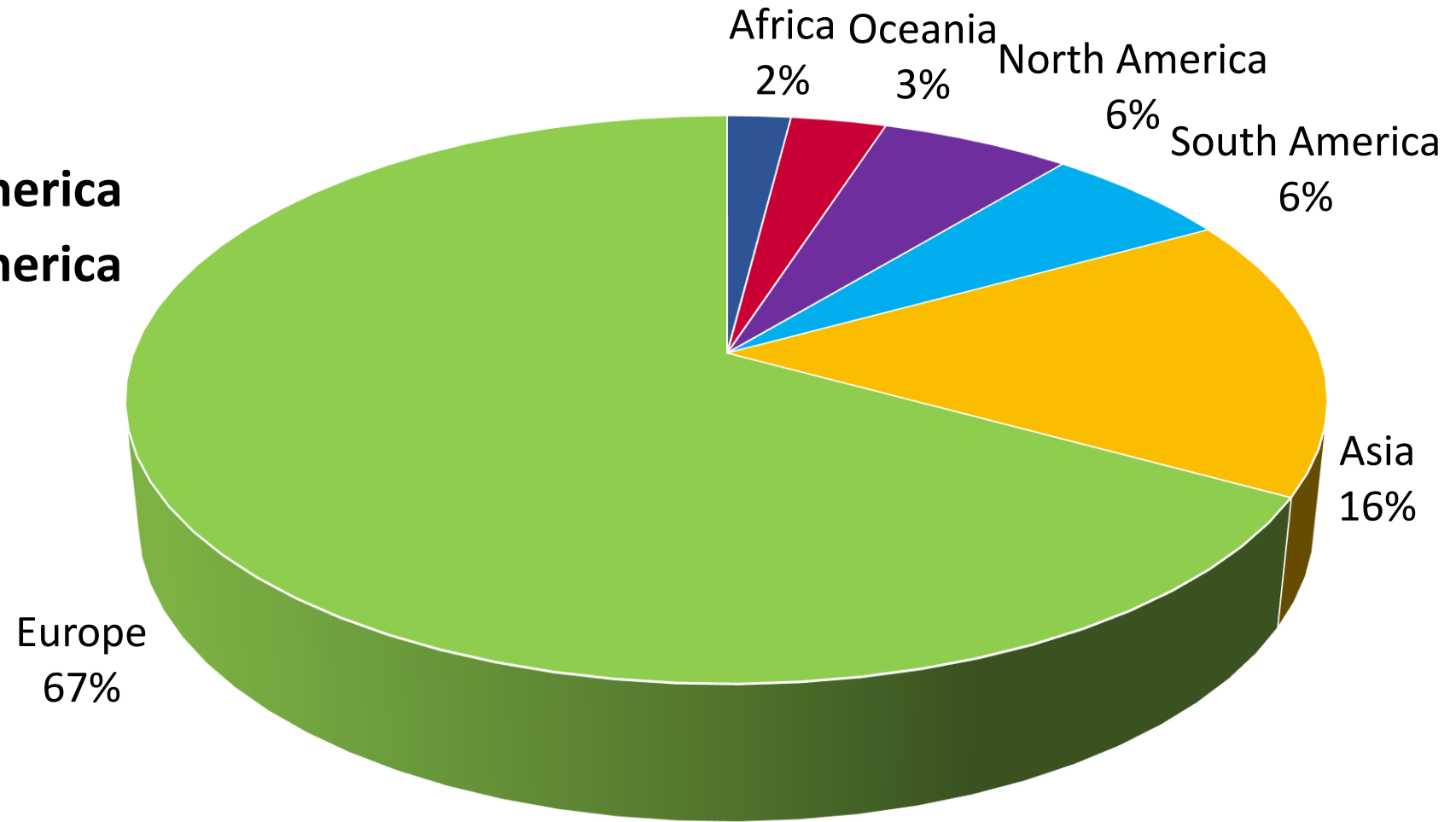

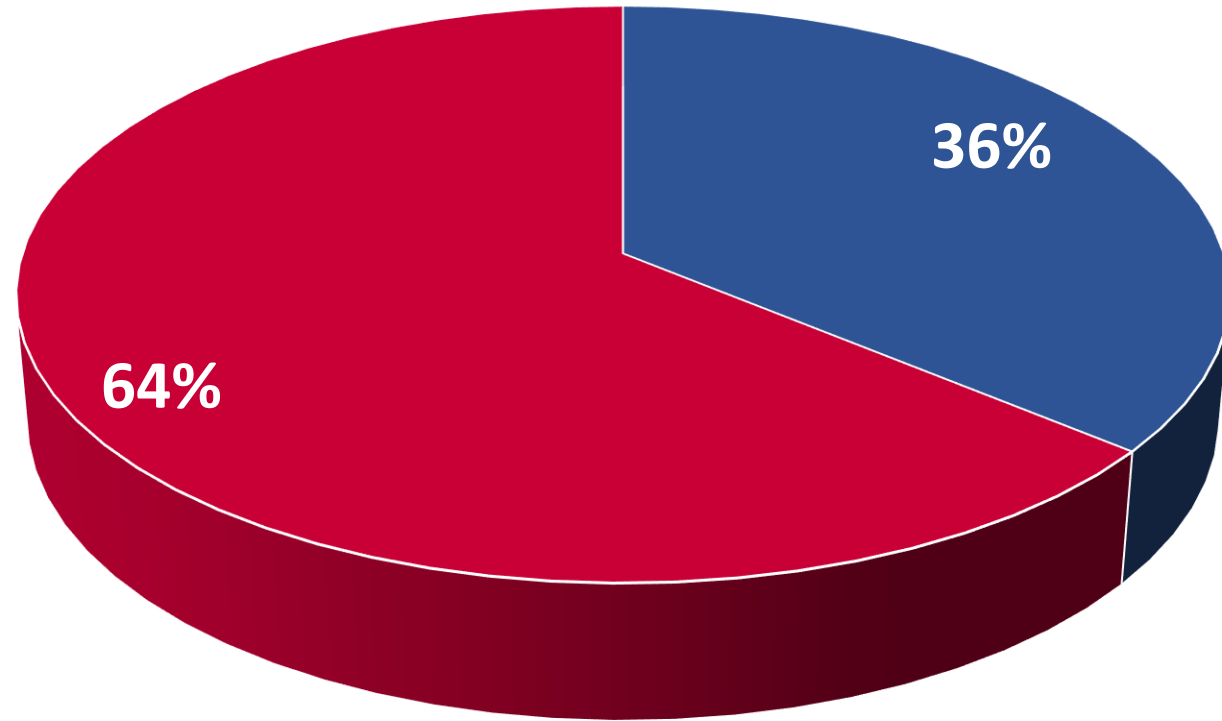

Age distribution



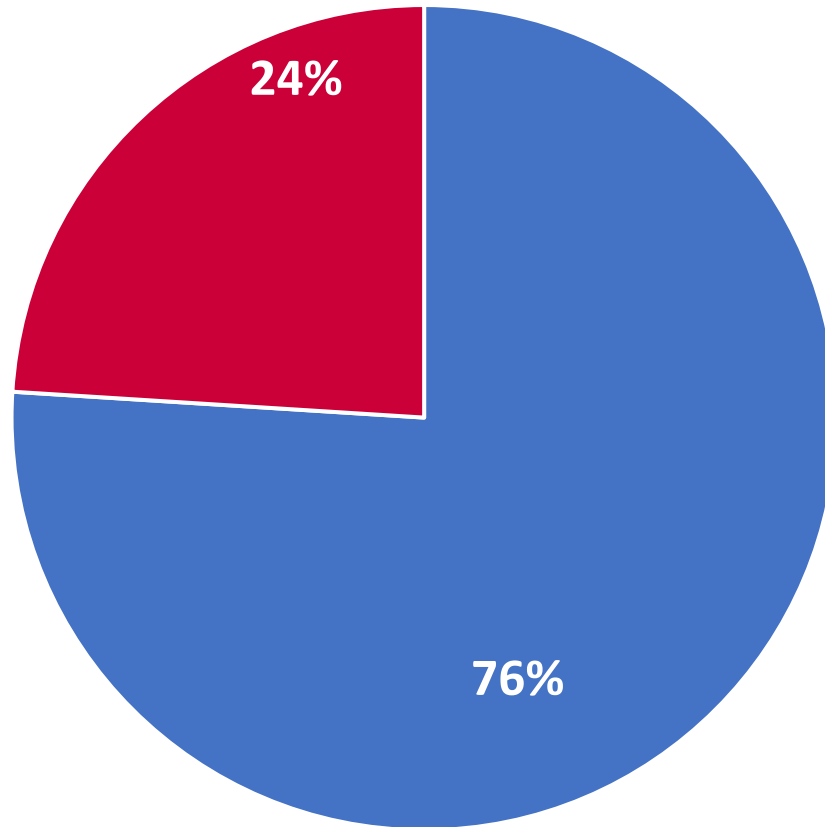

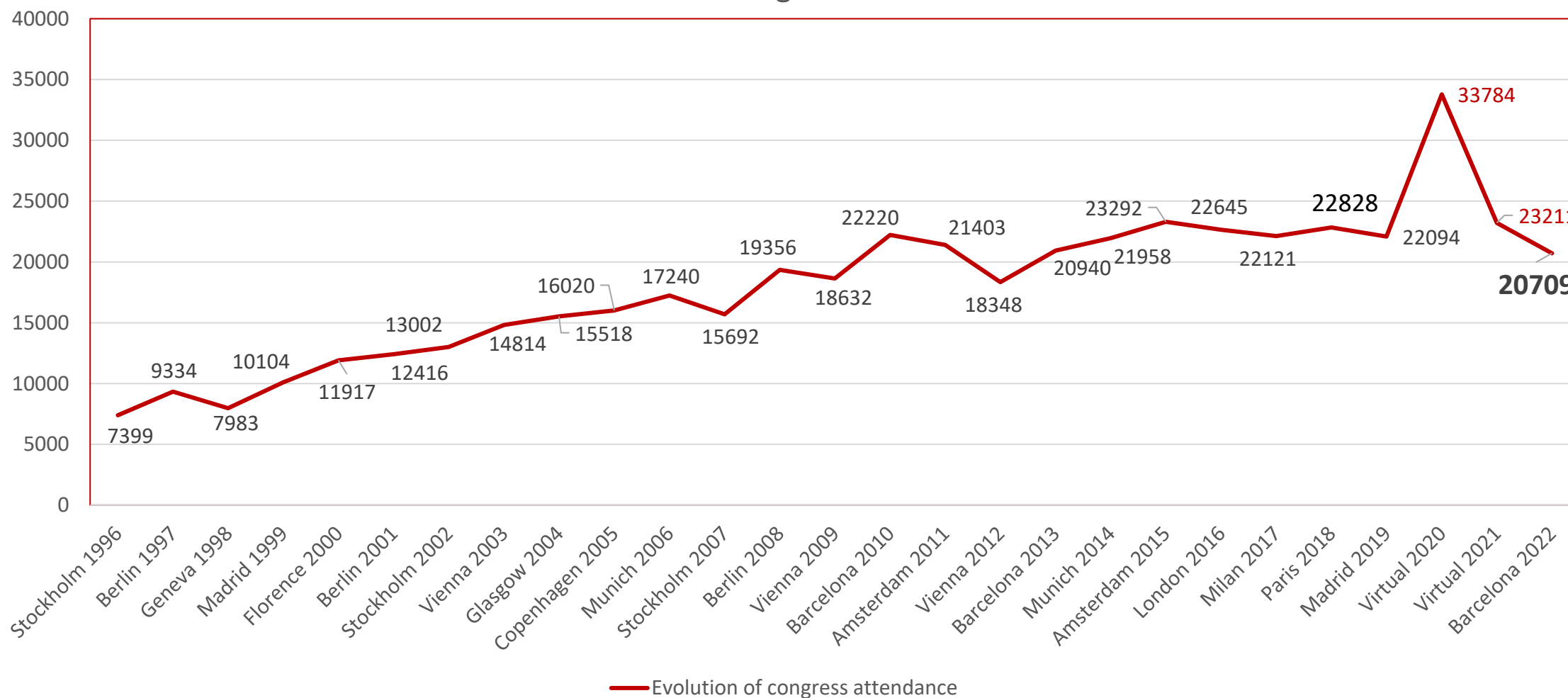

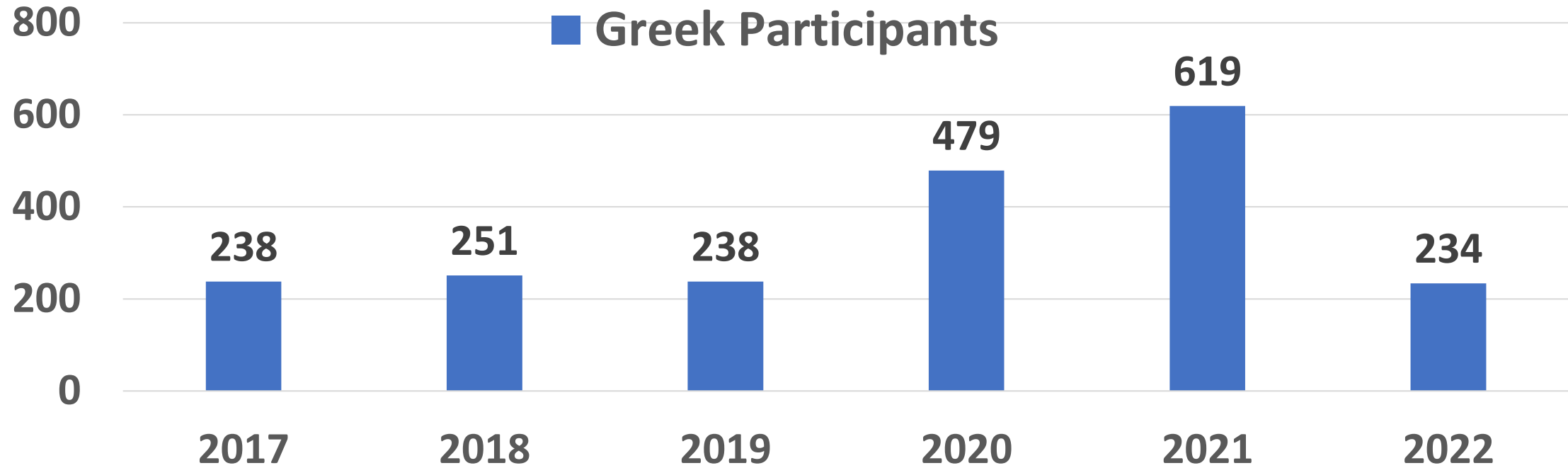

- Last year hundreds of people took part, and this year we want to engage even more people in walking, running or cycling to improve their lung health

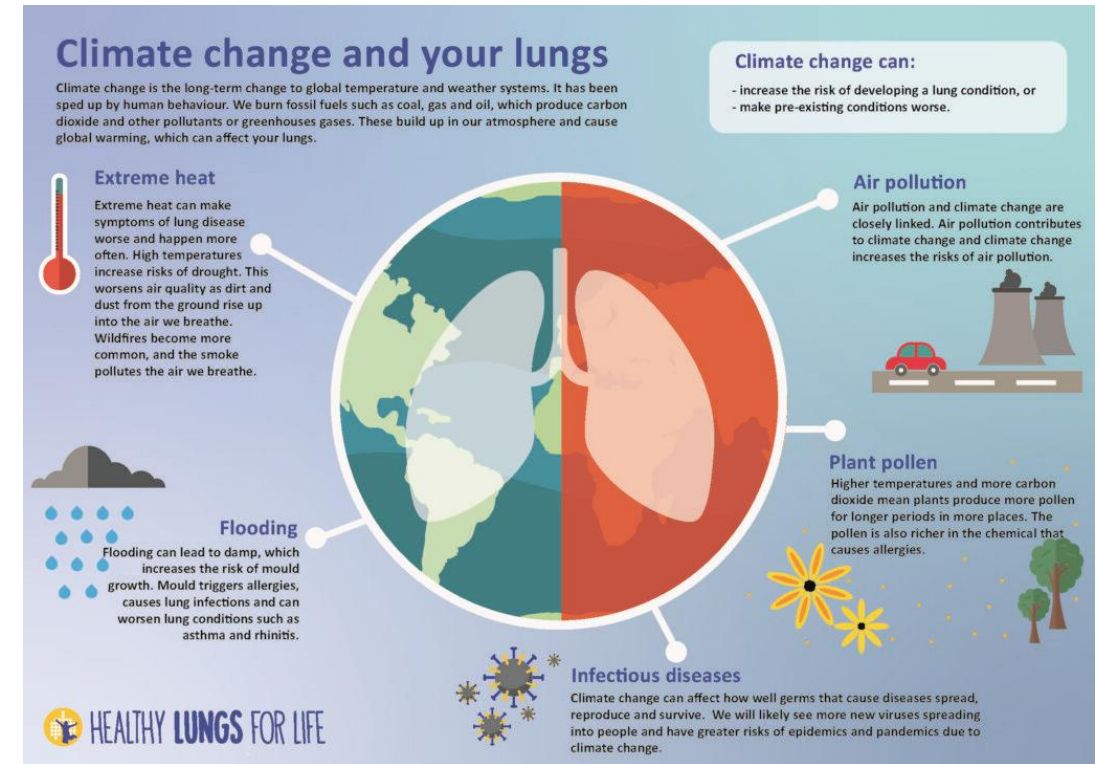


HLfL4schools



3-fold action for sustainable practices

- ❑ **Forestami:** congress-specific activities around Milan region with reforestation focus (outside tree planting season)
- ❑ **HLfL:** educational and information sessions to raise awareness in schools in Milan area (3+ years old)
- ❑ **MyClimate:** collaboration for a contribution to climate protection projects on **two levels**:
 1. Assess carbon footprint of office operations (CH, BXL, UK) and professional suggestions to **progressively** reduce corporate emissions.
 2. Calculate the unavoidable congress CO2 emissions and **gradually** implement a contribution to support certified climate Protection Projects.
